The applicant should demonstrate good moral character and judgement, can operate well under pressure, and possess strong problem-solving and leadership skills. As a member of our team, you will utilize your skills to protect life and property by preventing, combating, and extinguishing fires, and providing emergency medical care to the sick and injured at an advanced level.

Minimum Requirements:

- Applicants must be eighteen years of age to apply.
- A valid Rhode Island driver's license is required.
- A high school diploma or equivalency is required.
- Valid RI Advanced EMT-Cardiac (AEMT-C) or Paramedic license issued by the RI Department of Health is required.
- Certification in accordance with NFPA 1001 Firefighter I and II.
- A current RI Association of Fire Chiefs (RI AFC) Physical Performance Assessment Test (PPAT) certification will be required.
- Valid RI Association of Fire Chiefs Firefighter Entry Level Written Examination results with a score greater than or equal to 70 is required.

* Candidates that do not currently have the RIAFC PPAT or Written Exam requirements may apply with the condition that these requirements will be met prior to employment. Go to www.rifirechiefs.com for registration information and test dates.
