The Western Coventry Fire District is seeking qualified applicants for the position of Per-Diem Firefighter/EMT. The applicant should demonstrate good moral character and judgement, can operate well under pressure, and possess strong problem-solving and leadership skills. As a member of our team, you will utilize your skills to protect life and property by preventing, combating, and extinguishing fires, and providing emergency medical care to the sick and injured at an advanced level.

<u>Per Diem Firefighter/EMT positions</u>: The Western Coventry Fire District is currently accepting applications for per diem Firefighter/EMT positions with the potential for regular hours as a Firefighter/EMT based on the future growth and needs of the fire district. Hourly pay rates are listed below:

•	EMT-P License and Firefighter certification	\$27.50
•	EMT-C License and Firefighter certification	\$26.40
•	EMT-B License and Firefighter certification	\$21.90
•	EMT-P License only	\$24.00
•	EMT-C License only	\$21.90
•	EMT-B License only	\$19.60

Recommended requirements for Per Diem positions:

- Valid RI Emergency Medical Technician (EMT), Advanced EMT-Cardiac (AEMT-C) or Paramedic license issued by the RI Department of Health.
- Certification in accordance with NFPA 1001 Firefighter I and II.

Per diem employment opportunities, while available, may be limited for personnel until they are qualified to drive department apparatus, have attained firefighter certifications, and possess an EMT license.

Minimum qualifications for Per-Diem applicants:

- Applicants must be eighteen years of age to apply.
- A Rhode Island driver's license will be required.
- A high school diploma or equivalency is required.
