The Western Coventry Fire District is seeking qualified applicants for the position of Per-Diem Firefighter/EMT. The applicant should demonstrate good moral character and judgement, can operate well under pressure, and possess strong problem-solving and leadership skills. As a member of our team, you will utilize your skills to protect life and property by preventing, combating, and extinguishing fires, and providing emergency medical care to the sick and injured at an advanced level.

Per Diem Firefighter/EMT positions: The Western Coventry Fire District is currently accepting applications for per diem Firefighter/EMT positions with the potential for regular hours as a Firefighter/EMT based on the future growth and needs of the fire district. Hourly pay rates are listed below:

Requirements to work shifts as a Per Diem Firefighter:

- Valid RI Emergency Medical Technician (EMT), Advanced EMT-Cardiac (AEMT-C) or Paramedic license issued by the RI Department of Health.
- Certification in accordance with NFPA 1001 Firefighter I and II.

Minimum qualifications for member applicants:

- Applicants must be eighteen years of age to apply.
- A Rhode Island driver's license will be required.
- Applicant must provide an official copy of their driving record.
- A high school diploma or equivalency is required.
- Successful Completion of the RIAFC Written Examination
- Successful Completion of the RIAFC Physical Agility Exam
- National Background Check
- Medically FIT for Duty, to be determined by a NFPA Physical.

Candidates who meet the minimum qualifications, however, have yet to acquire there EMT and Firefighting credentials may be enrolled in our training program.
